

# **Rules for NorCal Heat Tournaments for Players ages and Playing on Multiple Teams**

- 1. All players must have an AAU card or AAU number listed on the team roster**
- 2. A player may play up at any level at any time**
- 3. A team is allowed up to 2 age exceptions (Up to 1 year) on their team. This means that a 6th grade team is allowed up to two 7th graders on their team.**
- 4. A player may play on two different teams and/or Clubs as long as the following are respected:**
  - a. A player may play down one age group on a different team/club if and only if the team has 7 or less players and is not already over the age exception limit**
  - b. A player may play on two different teams/clubs if those teams are in different age groups. I.e play for one team as a 6th grader and play for a different team/club at the 7th grade level.**
  - c. A player may play on two different teams/clubs as long as they are not in the same bracket. I.e. play for one 7th grade team in the Gold bracket and then play for a different team/club in the Silver bracket.**
  - d. That play must be listed on the roster at the scorers table before the game starts.**
  - e. The tourney will not guarantee that games will not overlap for these situations, if they work great, if they don't the athlete will need to choose.**
- 5. The tournament Director can be contacted to clarify any situations and they have the authority to adjust/interpret the rules in the best interest of the tournament and fair play to all teams involved.**
